We have been informed that one of our students who returned to Singapore from his exchange programme in the United Kingdom has been diagnosed with COVID-19 on 24 March 2020.

Since his return to Singapore on 22 March 2020 afternoon, he had been serving his 14-day Stay Home Notice. He was unwell on 23 March 2020, and went for testing at NCID immediately.

The student has not been back at the SMU campus since 3 January 2020. In addition, our Office of Safety and Security has established that he has not had any contact with anyone from the University since his return.

We hope that he makes a full recovery soon and have reached out to him to provide the necessary assistance and support.

At the same time, we would like to remind our community that if you have a fever, cough, sore throat, or any other signs of being unwell, please seek medical attention immediately. All of us can play a role in safeguarding the well-being and health of our SMU community.
