Dear UG students

In the last few days, the Ministry of Health and Ministry of Manpower have issued advisories that tighten the safety measures at workplaces, such as disallowing social gatherings and interactions at workplaces. These came after a recent rise in the number of COVID-19 cases in Singapore.

The University recognizes the benefits of face-to-face interactions, discussions, and presentations. At the same time, however, we need to play our part in reducing physical interactions so as to contain the spread of the coronavirus. While it was announced on 31 August 2021 that we will move a number of classes back on campus from 13 September 2021, conditions have changed over the past week. Regrettably, we now need to readjust our instructional approaches and **we will continue to conduct all UG classes online until 10 October 2021.**

Please note that under certain circumstances, assessments such as mid-term tests may be conducted on campus. In such cases, your instructors will inform you of the assessment plan ahead of time. Measures will be put in place to ensure the safe conduct of such assessments.

I will write to you again in early October and hope we will then be able to reinstate our plans to bring classes back on campus for the remaining weeks of the term. Thank you for your forbearance and understanding in what is a difficult and dynamic situation.
