MESSAGE FROM VICE PROVOST (EDUCATION)



Dear colleagues

I last communicated to you on our instructional and exams plans on 18 March 2022. We have been actively monitoring the COVID situation and since my last message, the week-on-week infection ratio in Singapore has been consistently below 1. From 26 April 2022, Singapore is stepping down the national DORSCON from orange to yellow.

Therefore, effective 1 May 2022, we will conduct all classes on campus by default for all UG and PG programmes, except for classes which are designed to be conducted in a blended learning approach. Instructors will be given the discretion to provide remote learning opportunities for students who are on medical leave, but such remote learning should not otherwise be used as an alternative to on-campus classes.

Similarly, from 1 May 2022, all exams will be held on campus by default. We will no longer provide concurrent remote online exams. Students who are unable to attend the on-campus exams for medical or compassionate reasons will need to take an I-grade or sit for a make-up exam. Students may refer to the exams policy or approach their School/Programme Office for assistance where necessary. For the avoidance of doubt, the policy will apply to only exams from 1 May 2022 onwards and will not affect the ongoing UG AY2021/22 Term 2 exams. I appreciate your continued support. Thank you and I wish you the best for the summer ahead!
